

> Your Court Late Fees May Have Been Eliminated or Reduced!



A new law (AB 199)

- **cancel**s civil assessment late fees (from before 7/1/22), and
- **lowers** new civil assessment late fees to \$100 or less

Are you paying money that you should not owe?

1. Check your record using the court's website, *or* by speaking with court staff on the phone or in-person.
2. Confirm that any civil assessment late fee added before 7/1/22 is cancelled and new late fees are no more than \$100.
3. If you are asked to pay money that you suspect you do not owe, get legal help from your lawyer or a legal aid office.

If you cannot afford to pay your remaining balance, contact your court or a legal aid organization to ask if you qualify for a reduction or elimination of your fees.
