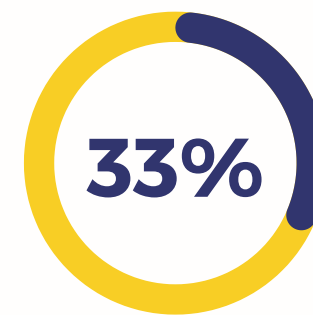
## EBCLC's FY 2022 Achievements

EBCLC's Board Chair and Executive Director identify as African American women.



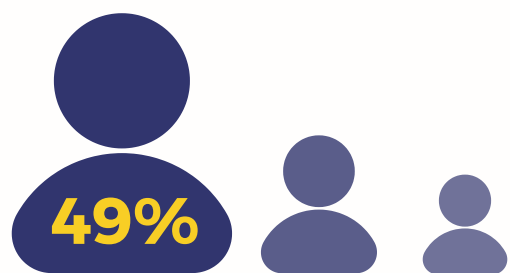
1 out of every 3 clients who sought assistance with **critical housing problems** self-identified as Black Women.



Over 2/3 of our youth clients access our **education and justice services** because of a woman of color caregiver.



EBCLC secured **funds and public benefits** for women of color and their families.



Women of color make up the **largest constituency served by EBCLC.**



342 women of color entrusted EBCLC to help them secure **immigration relief.**
